Manual Transfer Switches, Inlet Boxes, & Power Cords

Portable Generator Accessory Installation Guide

Eliminate the risk of backfeeding the electrical utility during a power outage by isolating the circuits using generator power from the rest of the building. The National Electrical Code (NFPA 70, Article 702.6) mandates that a transfer switch be installed with all standby power systems, including portable generators. Select the circuits most needed during an outage and connect them to the transfer switch in combination with appropriate power inlet boxes and cords.
